Thema „Exploring Polarities - A Dialogue in Europe“

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As tango dancers and Spiral Dynamics teachers, we continuously explore the interplay of polarities. In the dance between leader and follower, and vice versa, opposing forces attract each other to maintain balance. Just like inhaling and exhaling, each 'pole' cannot exist without the other. For this communication to work in dance, know-how is essential - a shared vocabulary that is continuously developed and refined so that both partners can speak a common language.

This workshop focuses on the aspect of 'Know-How,' the developed communication we use as tango dancers. The goal is not one-sided communication but mutual exchange within the dance and the couple. To achieve this, we use motion analysis, asking ourselves: How do I take a step? How many steps are possible? How do I lead my partner into a movement? How do leadership impulses work?
